Richland Public Library COMPUTER, INTERNET AND WI-FI POLICY

Purpose:

Richland Public Library provides public use computers and access to the Internet to enhance and support the community's access to information, encourage lifelong learning and provide social and leisure activities.

Internet Use By The Public:

Use of the Richland Public Library's Internet connection in an illegal, disruptive or destructive manner is strictly forbidden. Since the library is a public place, staff may limit images displayed on screens in order to ensure the secure and comfortable environment of the Library. Use of the library's wireless access point will conform to these same policies. Noncompliance may result in the loss of Internet and computer privileges.

Patrons must sign-in at the front desk and agree to abide by this policy before using a computer or using the library's wireless access point. For those using the library's computers, there is a 30 minute time limit per person per day unless prior arrangements have been made with the librarian.
